DEAR FRIENDS OF NOUVEL






NOUVEL ACHIEVES 4% GROWTH



Nouvel Catholic Central was blessed with 93% re-enrollment of our students. A record number of admission inquiries and tours contributed to 4% overall growth over the 2020-2021 academic year. The high school campus currently serves 207 students as more and more families continue to desire a Catholic education for their children. We proudly welcomed 69 new students to the Nouvel Family from several different faith traditions.

Few Catholic schools were established with the intent of having tuition cover all expenses. Parish support, the generosity of friends and benefactors, along with fundraising has been and remains an essential component of our funding model. Catholic schools teach students by forming their whole being: body, mind, and soul so they may fulfill their God-given potential to become the people God is calling them to be and in so doing, serve their neighbors, contribute to their communities, and find joy in their lives.

Participating parishes contribute 25% of collections to Nouvel's Catholic Central's operating budget. 


